Code of Conduct (Mountain Copy)

All members of Montage Mountain Ski Team, All Season Program and volunteers are expected to follow the Montage Mountain Ski Team / All Season Program code of conduct, which is based on the United States Ski Association Code of Conduct. All members shall maintain high standards of moral and ethical conduct including but not limited to: Following *Your Responsibility Code, Self Control, Responsible behavior and honesty, Consideration for others, Treating people and their property with respect, Physical and emotional well being* and *Good manners in Public*. Failure to adhere to the code of conduct can result in disciplinary measures set forth by the Disciplinary Board of the Montage Mountain Ski Team / All Season Program.

Safety: Montage Mountain Ski Team & All Season Program members are expected to train in a safe manner. It is critical that we all act in a safe manner through out the year. Ensure your safety and the safety of others by using common sense. If participating in any activity that you are uncomfortable with or you feel is above your ability notify the coach immediately. When skiing is part of the training everyone is expected to follow the Skiers' & Riders' *Responsibility Code* whether we are at Montage Mountain or any other mountain. Ski Team members must ride the chairlift with the safety bar down, respect others in lift lines and on the slopes. Additionally if we are training at other venues everyone is expected to follow that venues rules and regulations. Members must remain with the group unless a coach reassigns them. Any member who wishes to leave the group for any reason must seek permission from the coach. Montage Mountain encourages everyone to wear proper safety equipment appropriate for that activity. Montage Mountain Ski Team / Program coaches have the authority to ban any member from any activity if it is determined that they do not have the proper safety equipment or their equipment is deemed unsafe.

Drugs, Alcohol and Tobacco: The use of illegal substances will not be tolerated. Alcohol and Tobacco products will be considered illegal substances if they are possessed by and/or consumed by team members who are not of legal age according to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Any club member who is taking any medication that may cause any impairment in functioning is required to notify a coach prior to participating in any club activity.

Dishonesty: Dishonesty will not be tolerated.

Violent and Aggressive Behavior: Violent and/or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.

Profanity and Abusive Language: The use of profanity and/or abusive language will not be tolerated.

Disruptive Behavior: All members who have joined the Montage Mountain Ski Team / All Season Program have made a commitment to become better racers and free riders. Training should be fun but disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. It is unfair to the coaches and other members in the group.

Good Sportsmanship: Ski Racing/Freestyle is an individual sport but all members of the Montage Mountain Ski Team / All Season Program are team members. All members are expected to behave as a team. Support of team members through positive reinforcement and encouragement not only encourages individual growth but also is essential to building team cohesiveness.

Punctuality/Preparedness: All members are expected to be on time for training events and to be prepared for that day's activities by bringing the proper equipment. Team members arriving late for training may not be allowed to join in for that session.

Effort and Attitude: The Montage Mountain Ski Team coaches recognize that we have members of all abilities and skill levels. We expect all members to show a positive attitude and to give their best efforts during training.

COVID 19 Guidelines: All members of the team must follow current CDC guidelines to prevent COVID from being spread from one team mate to another. IF YOU ARE SICK, STAY HOME. Do not come to the Ski Team sessions.

The Montage Mountain Ski Team coaches encourage all members to follow the Code of Conduct at all times, when at Montage Mountain or any other venues.

MONTAGE MOUNTAIN SKI TEAM / ALL SEASON PROGRAM DISCIPLINARY POLICY

Disciplinary measures include verbal warning, written warning, suspension and expulsion. Generally a participant will be given a verbal warning first, followed by a written warning, then suspension(s) and finally expulsion. However if the offense is deemed serious or no effort is made to improve then any of the disciplinary measures can be invoked at any time. All disciplinary measures will be handled by the disciplinary board which will consist of the Head Coach, Race Director and Ski & Snowboard School Director.

The disciplinary measures are explained as follow:

1. Verbal Warning – The team member and parent will be advised of the nature of the offense and what is expected in the future.
2. Written Warning – The team member and parent will receive written notification of the rule violation along with an expectation to correct the behavior.
3. Suspension – If no effort is put forth to correct behavior after verbal and/or written warning (s) then the team member maybe suspended for a period of time. However, if the offense is deemed to be serious enough then suspension may be invoked without prior verbal or written warnings. The team member and parent will be informed of the reason for the suspension and the length of the suspension in writing. The team member and parent will be expected, prior to the suspension being lifted, to discuss with the disciplinary board, how they will ensure the behavior will not be repeated in the future.
4. Expulsion - Repeated violations or offenses deemed to be extremely serious will result in permanent expulsion from the team for the remainder of the year. The team member and parent will be informed of expulsions verbally and in writing. This will include competing with the team at events. If the team member wishes to return to the team the next season they and parent (s) will need to meet with team personnel prior to any decision being made. Expulsion will also result in forfeiting any training fees paid for that year.

Team members and parents will always have the opportunity to discuss with the disciplinary board any disciplinary measures received.
